2.4 Media Specifications

A wide variety of label stock can be used in the printer. Refer to the following specifications and settings before ordering custom stock from DTM.

Important! Test all custom made label stock with the intended printer before ordering large quantities!

The media stock must have one of the following sensormarks:

Black mark

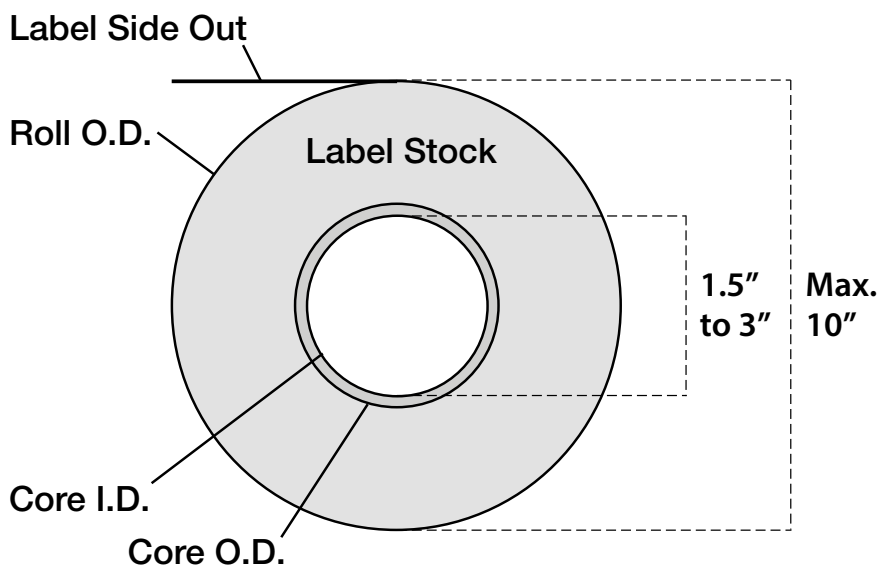
Use black mark for label material where a black pre-printed line on the back of the label stock indicates the break between labels. Black marks are required on clear label stock rolls, or label where the label waste matrix (waste) is left on the liner. Black marks can also be used for irregular shaped labels, circles larger than 4 inches or on any stock where the print starting position can not be sensed using the label itself.

Should be opaque to infrared light. The mark should be between the labels. The end of the mark should correspond with the beginning of the label.

Continuous

If you have continuous stock with no die-cut, reflective mark or holes, set the sensor type to Continuous. This will turn off the stock sensor. In this mode there is no way to set the print starting position. The printer will simply start printing the first label and print each subsequent label immediately after that previous one. To produce a gap between prints simply add the desired amount of white space to the end of the label being printed.

Important! For pre-printed continuous substrate black mark is mandatory.



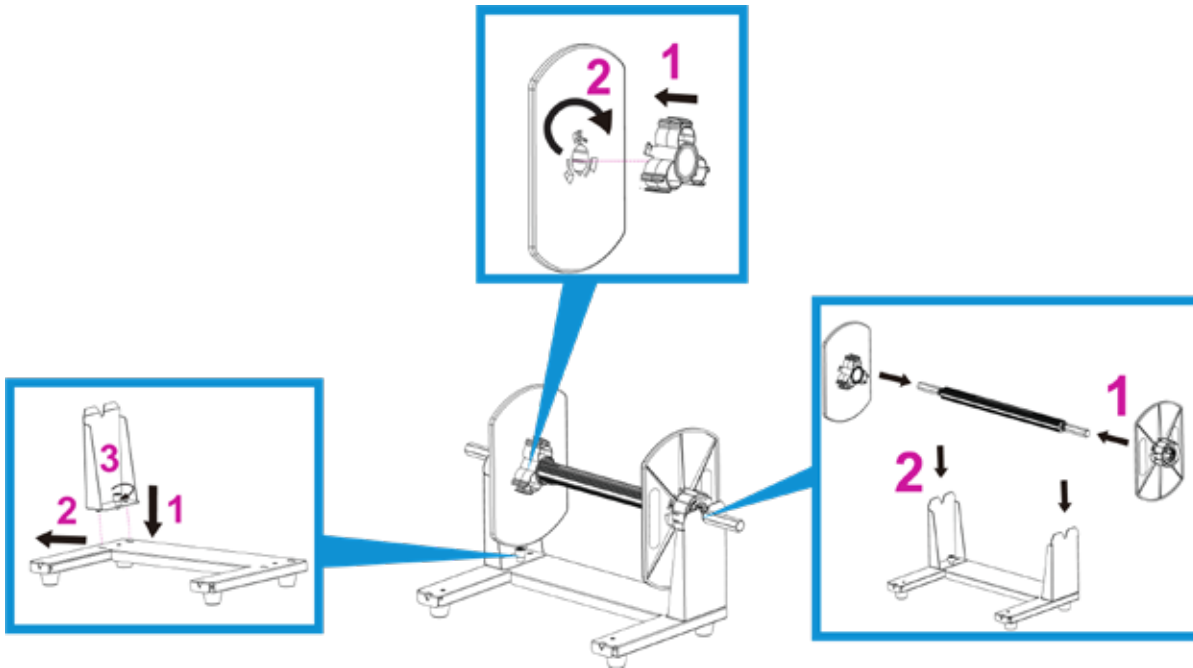
Note on Label Orientation

If you are using an applicator to apply your labels, be sure to order label stock with the correct orientation for your applicator. For example most applicators will apply the side of the label first, so you will want to print the labels sideways.

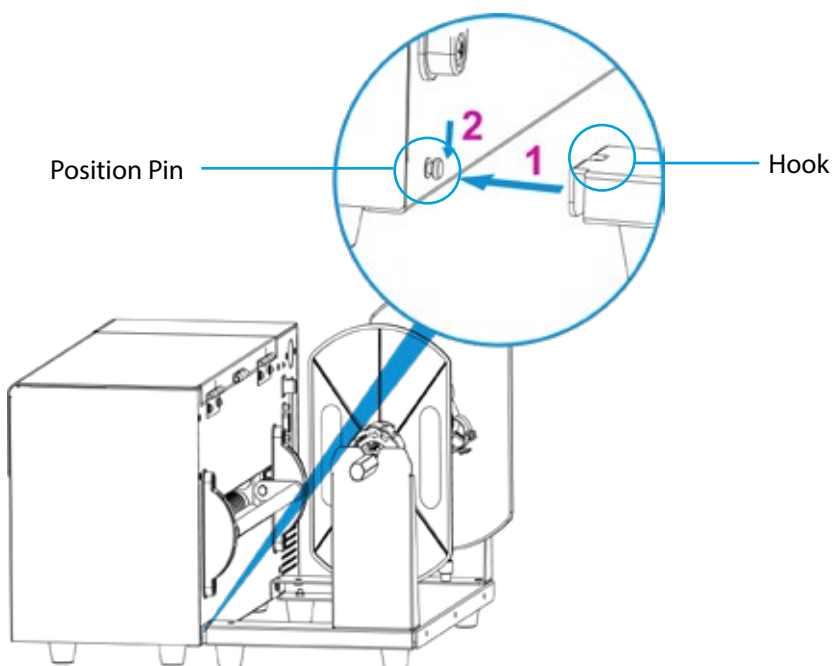

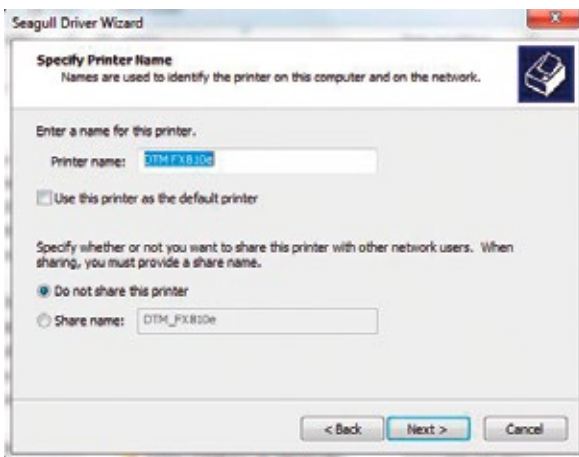


2.6 Installing The Driver

1. Download the driver at dtm-print.eu/download
2. Select the icon for the driver file and double-click to start the installation.
3. Follow the instructions on the screen. The Driver Wizard guides you through the installation procedure.
4. Select "Install printer drivers".
5. Choose "DTM FX810e"



6. Enter a printer name and assign the appropriate rights.



7. Once the installation is complete, a summary of the printer settings is displayed.
8. Check whether the printer settings are correct and click "Finish" to start copying the driver files.

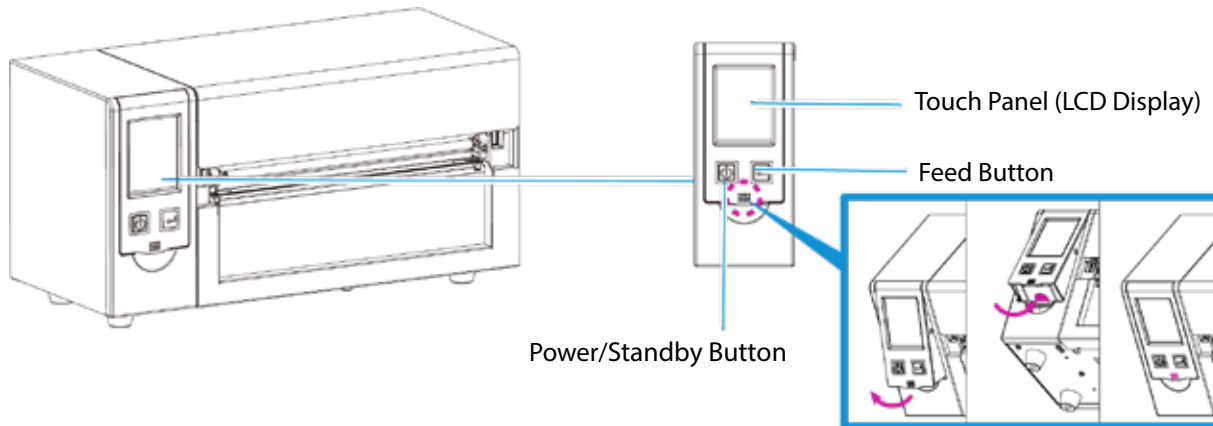


9. Wait until copying is complete, then finish the installation.
10. Once the driver installation is complete, the new printer should appear in the "Devices and Printer" folder.



Section 3: Printer Operation

3.1 Printer Operation Interface



Standby button

Make sure the power switch is on. pressing the "Standby button", wakes up the printer and the display will show "Ready". Press and hold the "standby button" for 3 seconds will set the printer back in Standby Mode.

Feed button

When pressing the FEED button, the printer moves the label to the defined stop position. If you are using continuous labels, pressing the FEED button will move label stock until you release the button again. If you are using individual labels, pressing the FEED button will move only one label. If the label does not stop at the correct position, please run the auto calibration (See Section 3.4 Label size calibration and Self Test Page) for the label size calibration function on the label stock.

Pause _ Feed button

If you want to pause the printing, press the feed button. The printer will be on pause status, the LCD will show "Pause" till you press the feed button again to release the Pause Mode.

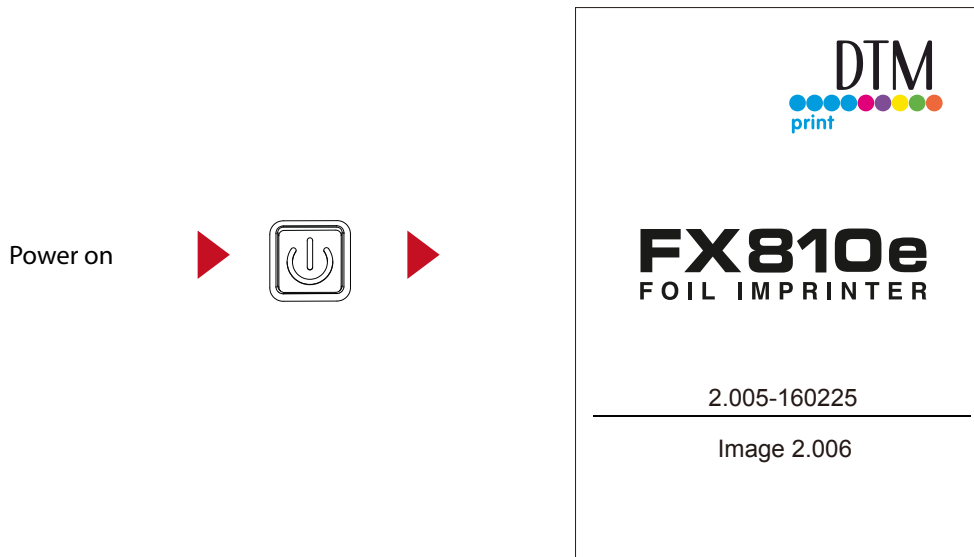
Cancel Printing_ Feed key

Press and hold feed key for 3 seconds during printing will clear the print job and the Printer will be set to standby mode.

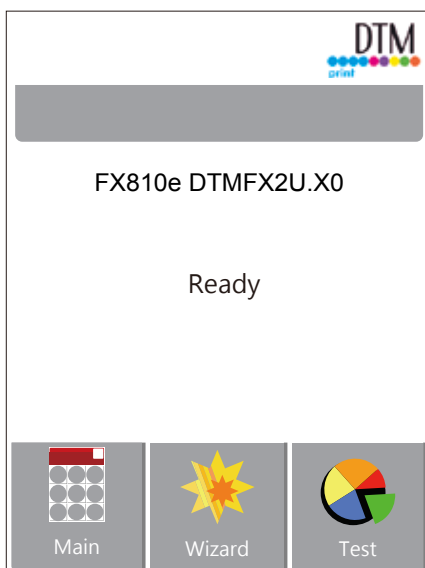

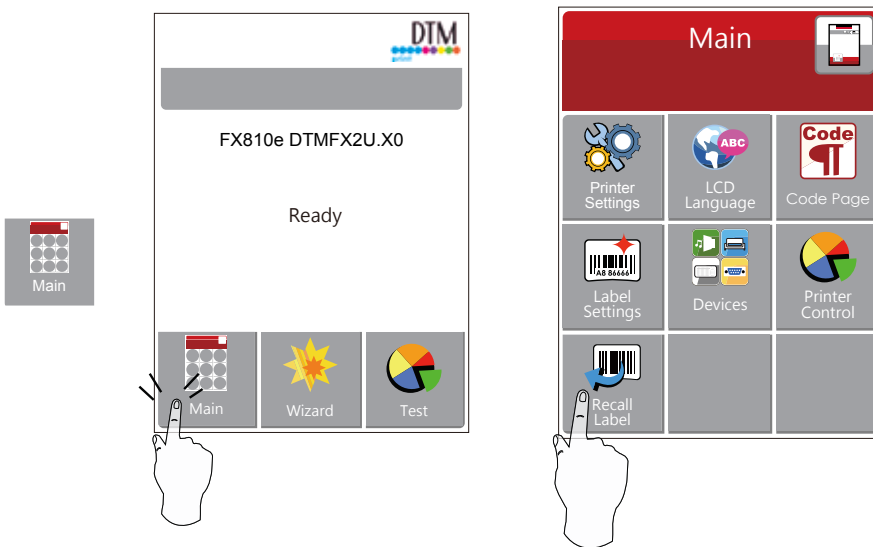


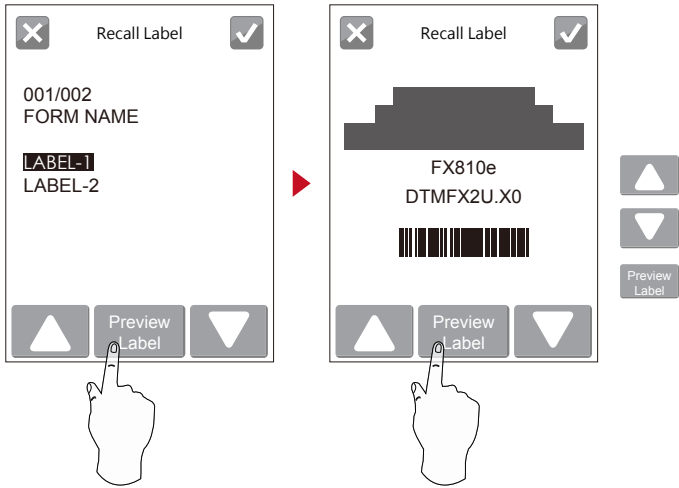
Keyboard Mode

Tap on Main and then on Recall Label to recall the label.

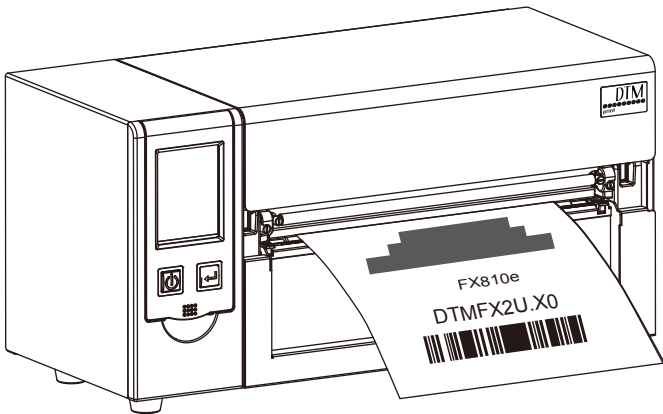




The touch panel shows all labels. The Data processing time will be extend as long as the labels increase.

3.4 Label size calibration and Self Test Page

The printer can automatically detect and store label height. That means the host computer does not need to transmit the label height to the printer. And the self self-test function lets you check whether the printer is functioning normally. Here is how you run the label size calibration and self test test.

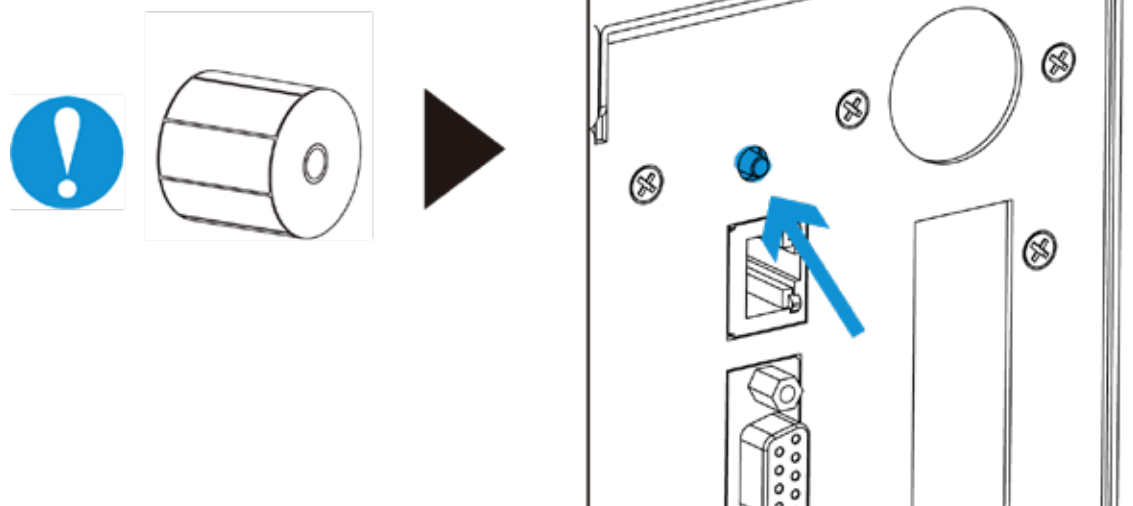
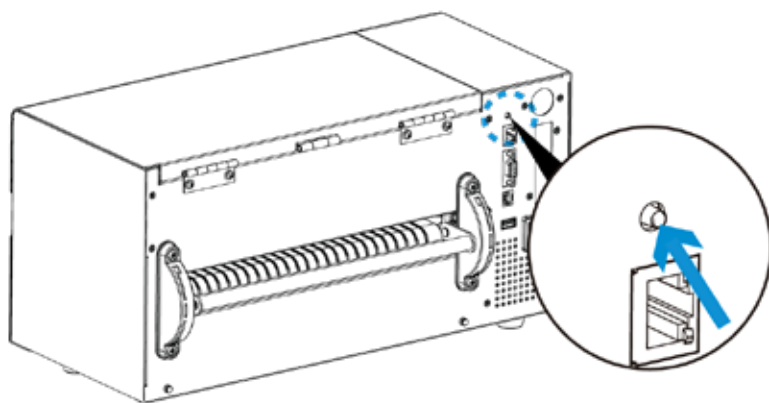
- Step 1 Check that the label stock is loaded correctly.
- Step 2 Switch off the printer.
- Step 3 Switch the printer on again, keeping the FEED button pressed. When the READY LED starts to flash red and the STATUS LED lights up orange, release the FEED button. The printer will now measure the label stock and store the label height
- Step 4 Once the printer has successfully measured the label stock, it will print a self self-test label.

3.6 Connected with USB Devices

USB Host port supports USB memory stick, USB keyboard or scanner.

USB memory stick: It extends the user memory space for Graphic, Font, Label Foemat, DBF and Command file downloading. The printer's Firmware also can be updating if copy new version of Firmware into USB memory stick.

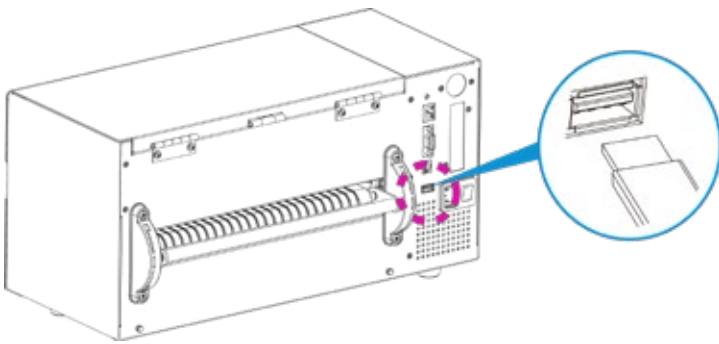
Connecting an USB keyboard to printer for "Keyboard Mode" mode operation.

Usage of Extended Memory

USB memory stick: It supports hot-plugging function; printer will create a Folder "\LABELDIR" and switch " User Flash" to "Extended Memory" automatically while user plugs an USB memory stick into a printer.

Connect USB with the printer; To connect PC and printer through USB.



Usage of Firmware Update

- ▶ Remove USB memory stick from printer and plug-in it to a PC's USB port.
- ▶ Copy a new version of firmware "xxx.bin" to the Folder "\LABELDIR\FW"
- ▶ Remove USB from PC and plug-in back to the printer. The printer will update the Firmware automatically
- ▶ The "\LABELDIR\FW" directory allows only one file exist, if there are multiple files, the files will be confused.
- ▶ Don't remove the USB memory stick out while it's under updating with "Flash Writing ..." message that displays on LCD panel

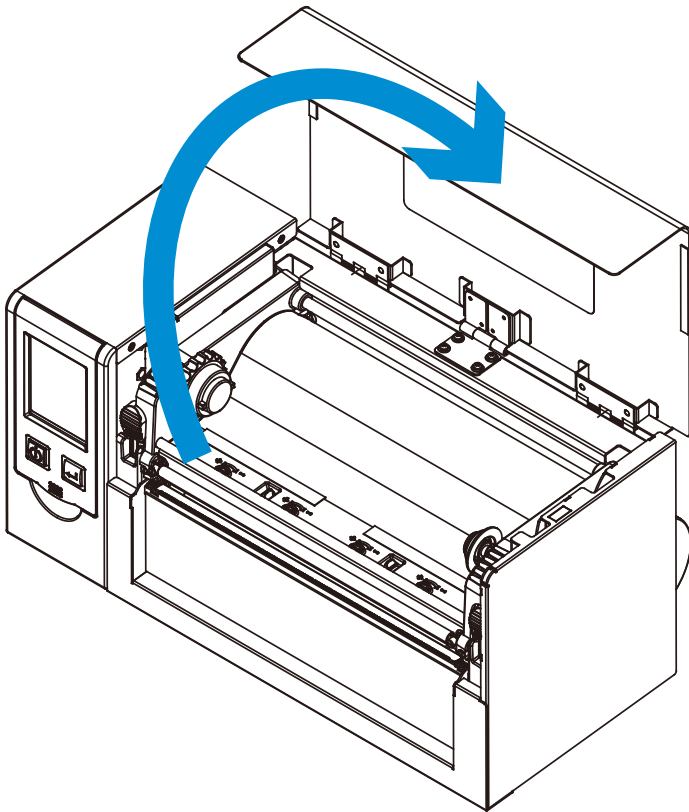
- ▶ When plug-in an USB keyboard to the printer, LCD touch panel will display "Enter Standalone", press the "Y" key on keyboard to entering "keyboard Mode" operation. Under this model can perform "Recall Label", set "Country Code", "Code Page", "Clock Setting", "Database Setting" and "Label Edit".
- ▶ Connect a USB keyboard to the printer, if not into the keyboard mode, press the "N" key to leave.
- ▶ Into Standalone mode of operation, to leave the Standalone operation, press "ESC" key to exit.
- ▶ After leaving the keyboard mode, for re-entry, press the key "F1" key or reboot, you can follow the steps in the first step choose whether or not (Y/N) into the keyboard mode.

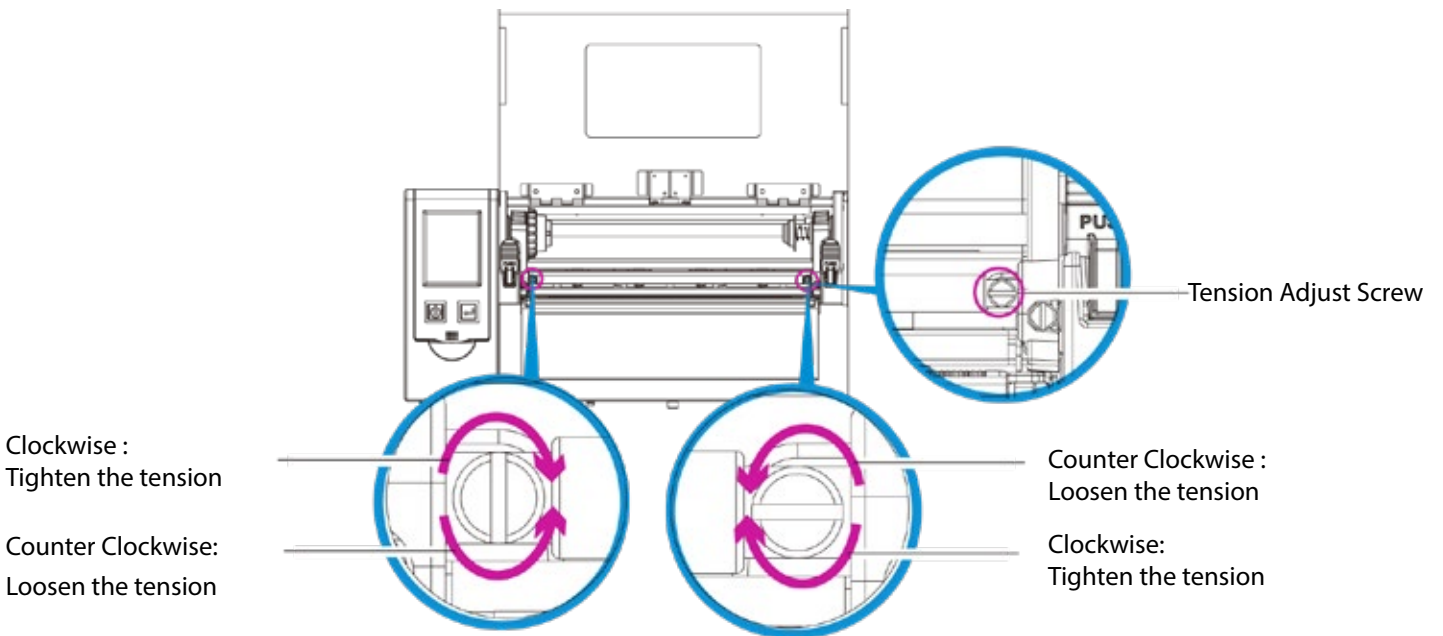


5.1 Print Line Adjustment



To have good print quality in hardness or thicker media, we will suggest to move the print line a little bit forward (paper feeding direction). Turn the flat screw driver (as above figure) in clockwise or counter clockwise to rotate the screws (A) to move back or forward the TPH position. The adjustment screw (A) of the left and right side of the print head position adjustment should be adjusted so that the print line is parallel to the center line of the roller. Adjust the screw (A) to rotate one turn, the print head displacement stroke is 0.5mm, it is recommended to adjust the way progressive, each time to adjust the 1/4 turn to confirm the print quality situation. (A) Turn the adjustment screw (A) on the left and right sides to the position where the adjustment line is aligned with the indicating line, and return to the original position and then adjust it again according to the above adjustment method.

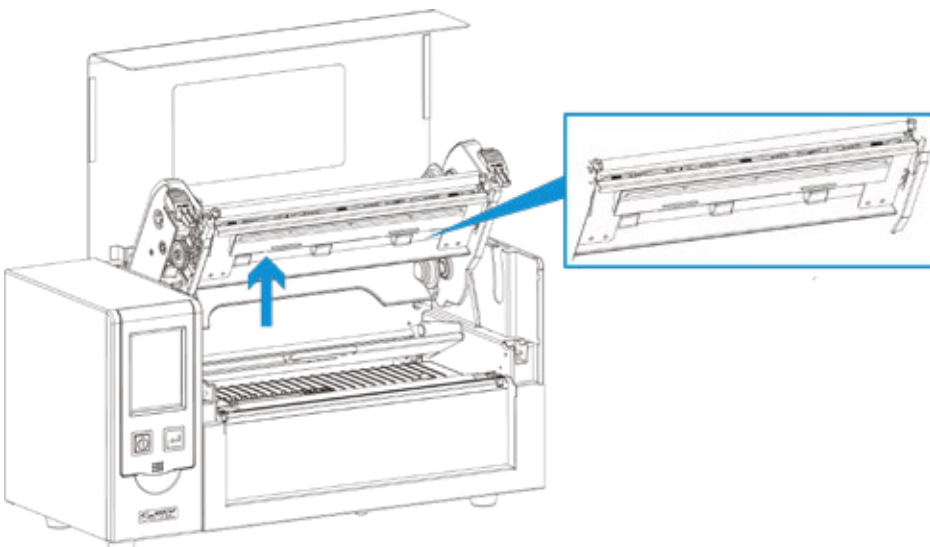

5.3 Print Head Cleaning

Dirt on the print head or ribbon, or glue residue from the label stock may result in inadequate print quality. The printer cover must therefore always be closed during printing. Keeping dirt and dust away from the paper or labels ensures a good print quality and a longer lifespan of the print head.

Switch the printer off to clean the printhead. To remove any label residue or other dirt from the print head, use a soft lint-free cloth dipped in alcohol.



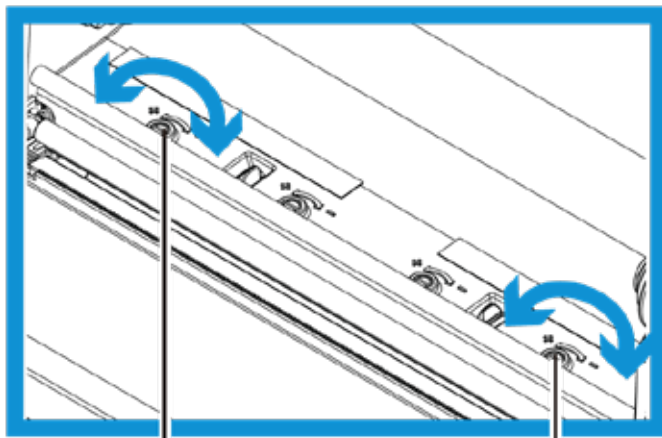
5.4 Print Head Pressure Adjustment

When printing on special media (with varying material thickness), the print quality may suffer. You will then need to adjust the print head pressure.

Use a screw driver and slowly turn the adjustment screws for the print head to increase or reduce the print head pressure.

Turn towards + (Plus): The pressure is increased

Turn towards - (Minus): The pressure is reduced

5.5 Ribbon Wrinkle Adjustment

The use of different ribbon materials may cause wrinkling of the ribbon, which in turn affects the print result as illustrated by the examples in (a) and (b). To change the print quality, you can adjust the adjustment screws like shown on Section 5.4.



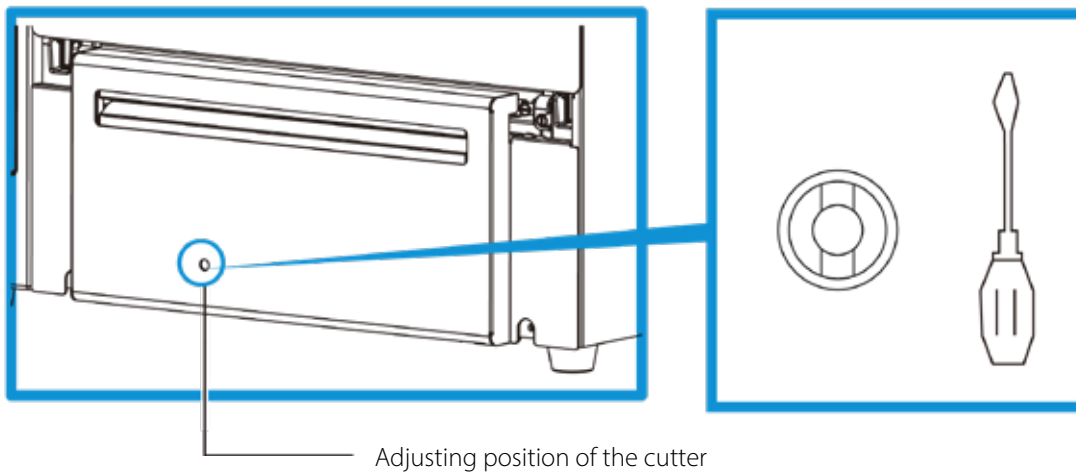
5.6 Cutter Error

While using the cutter, paper jams may occur. Please follow the below steps to clean the paper jam.

A socket head screw for adjusting the cutter is located on the bottom of cutter module, as shown in below illustration.

Switch off the printer. Use a screwdriver to turn the socket head screw and release the knife.

When you have cleared the paper jam, switch on the printer again. The cutter will automatically reset.



NOTE: Labels should be at least 30 mm high to ensure correct functioning of the cutter.

5.7 Troubleshooting
